Student Prerequisites:

- Age Requirement: Applicants must be at least 18 years old.
- CPR Certification: A valid Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers certification is required prior to enrollment.
- Reading Proficiency
 - Proof of a 9th-grade reading level is necessary. This can be
- Physical Examination
 - A comprehensive physical examination conducted by a licensed healthcare provider.
- Drug Screen
 - A negative 12-panel urine negative drug screening is mandated as part of admission and clinical participation.
- Immunizations
 - Tuberculosis (TB) Screening:
 - TB Skin Test (PPD): A negative result from a two-step PPD test administered within six months prior to the start of the course. If the initial test is positive, a negative chest X-ray taken within the same timeframe.
 - Hepatitis B:
 - Vaccination Series: Completion of the Hepatitis B vaccination series, which consists of three doses. Alternatively, documentation of a positive Hepatitis B surface antibody titer indicating immunity may be accepted.
 - Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR):
 - Vaccination Series: Proof of two doses of the MMR vaccine administered at least 28 days apart. A positive titer demonstrating immunity to all three diseases can also suffice.
 - Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap):
 - Vaccination: Documentation of a Tdap booster received within the last ten years.
 - Varicella (Chickenpox):
 - Vaccination Series: Two doses of the Varicella vaccine administered at least 30 days apart. Alternatively, a positive IgG titer indicating immunity or documented history of the disease may be acceptable.
