RRFD hosts propane training

The Rio Rico Medical and Fire District hosted a three-day propane training for neighboring firefighters, including some agencies from Sonora, according to information on its Facebook page.

The event, which wrapped up on Jan. 25, focused on enhancing firefighters' preparedness in handling propane-related incidents, RRFD said in its Facebook post.

Altogether, RRFD said, more than 150 participants from at least 30 agencies participate in the training. Some of those participants included Mexican firefighters from Huatabampo, Quiriego, Bacum, Empalme and Guaymas, according to the Association of Chiefs and Firefighters in Sonora.

"This collaboration not only strengthens our firefighters' preparedness, but it also positively impacts communities in Sonora," the Mexican agency said.

Multiple agencies respond to fire in Pete Kitchen

More than two-dozen first responders were dispatched to the Pete Kitchen area of Nogales Tuesday night, where a fire had engulfed a mobile home, according to Battalion Chief Christian Renteria of the Rio Rico Fire & Medical District.

No individuals were inside the building at the time of the fire, Renteria said, and no fire-related injuries were reported.

The fire was reported at 10:49 p.m. on Tuesday. Rio Rico, along with the Nogales and Tubac fire districts, responded to the

scene with a total of four engines.

"We had quite a bit of units," Renteria told the NI Wednesday.

Upon arriving at the residence on Pima Street, Renteria said, responders discovered defensive fire conditions - "which basically means we're going to fight the fire from the outside and not send anybody inside," he explained.

Aside from the trailer, one nearby vehicle was partially burned amid the fire, and another sustained heat damage.

Responders battled the blaze for nearly six hours,

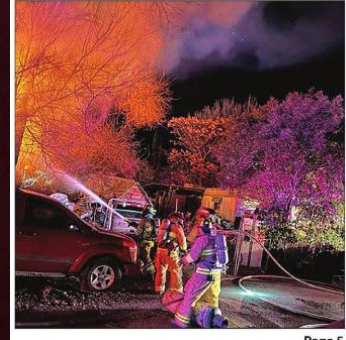
Renteria added, ultimately quenching the fire around 4:45 a.m.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation.

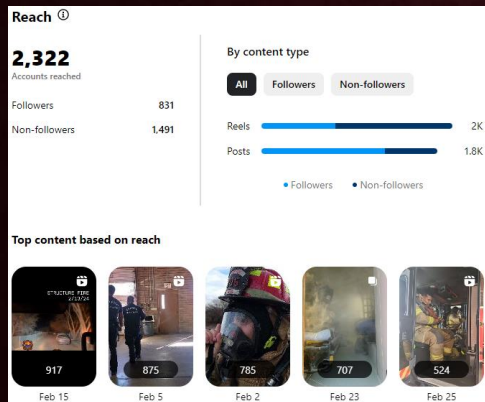
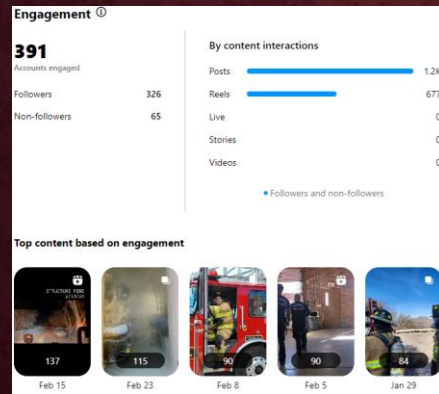
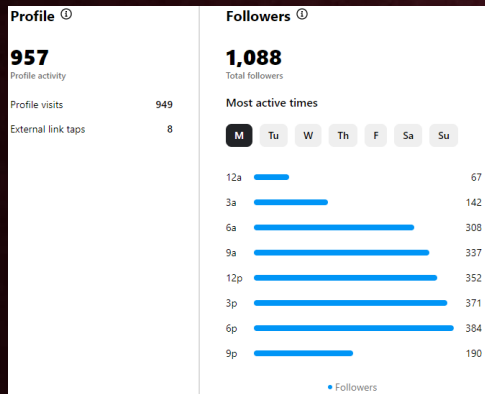
